The summer also brings exciting opportunities for your church to be a part of the mission work within your association. The biggest opportunity for you and your church to be involved in is Kentucky Changers. June 27<sup>th</sup> – July 3<sup>rd</sup> Kentucky Changers will be bringing a lot of workers to help do repairs to homes in Mason County for those who cannot do so themselves and they will be doing it for free. Your church can help in many ways. We need our churches to help deliver lunches to work crews as well as host crews for worship and Sunday lunch. We also need some volunteers to help serve breakfast and evening meals at the Mason County middle school where our crews will be staying. Your church office or pastor has already received information either by email or mail as to how you can help. Even if you cannot participate in the mission work please remember to pray for our crews and churches involved during that week.

Another mission opportunity for you to consider will be taking place September 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> as I will be

leading a team from our association to Camp Letourneau in Rushville, New York. Jamie Fischer who was a former youth pastor at May's Lick Baptist is now director of this camp and is needing some help. We will be doing roofing, painting and various other repairs. Lastly, we are as in the middle of planning an international mission trip for next Spring to church planting work in Pomacanchi, Peru.
